### **BOARD NOTICE 133 OF 2014**

### THE SOUTH AFRICAN PHARMACY COUNCIL

#### FEES PAYABLE TO THE COUNCIL UNDER THE PHARMACY ACT 53 OF 1974

In terms of section 4(zG) of the Pharmacy Act, 53 of 1974, as amended, Council may determine the fees payable to Council. This means that any new fees or amendments to existing fees are determined annually by Council. As in the past, all efforts are made to curtail costs and keep any increases in fees to the minimum.
